

# SUICIDE WARNING SIGNS

**These signs may mean someone is at risk for suicide. Risk is greater if a behavior is new or has increased, and if it seems related to a painful event, loss, or change.**

- ▶ Talking about wanting to die or kill oneself.
- ▶ Talking about feeling trapped or in unbearable pain.
- ▶ Changes in school or work performance.
- ▶ Talking about feeling hopeless or having no reason to live.
- ▶ Increased use of alcohol or drugs.
- ▶ Acting anxious or agitated; behaving recklessly.
- ▶ Sleeping too much or too little.
- ▶ Talking about being a burden to others.
- ▶ Extreme mood swings. Withdrawing or feeling isolated.
- ▶ Abrupt changes in behavior.
- ▶ Giving Away Possessions.
